DISEASE/CONDITION	EVALUATION DATA	DISPOSITION
A. Any history	Submit the following for FAA review: 1. A current, detailed Clinical Progress Note generated from a clinic visit with their treating physician (family medicine, internal medicine, endocrinology) no more than 90 days before the AME exam. <i>It should include a summary of the history of the condition or diagnosis; current medications, dosages, and side effects (if any); clinical exam findings; results of any testing performed; diagnosis; assessment and plan (prognosis); and follow-up.</i> 2. Lab: Performed no more than 90 days before the AME exam to include • Thyroid Stimulating Hormone (TSH), and • Any other lab already performed (e.g. T3, Free T4) by the treating physician. 3. Imaging: Copies of any imaging reports (MRI, CT, ultrasound, X-ray) already performed. 4. Any other testing deemed clinically necessary by the treating physician. 5. If previous thyroidectomy, submit operative report, History and Physical, and Discharge summary.	DEFER Submit the information to the FAA for a possible Special Issuance Annotate (elements or findings) in Block 60.
