All others</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• History of food impaction within the past year;</li> <li>• Symptomatic;</li> <li>• Not adequately treated;</li> <li>• Fibrostenotic disease</li> </ul>	<p>Submit the following for FAA review:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A current, detailed Clinical Progress Note generated from a clinic visit with the <b>Gastroenterologist (GI)</b> no more than 90 days prior to the AME exam. It must include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A detailed summary of the history of the condition;</li> <li>• Current medications, dosage, and side effects (if any);</li> <li>• Physical exam findings;</li> <li>• Results of any testing performed;</li> <li>• Diagnosis;</li> <li>• Assessment and Plan;</li> <li>• Prognosis and Follow-up.</li> </ul> </li> <li>2. It must specifically include if any history of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• complications such as food impaction,</li> <li>• need for endoscopic dilation</li> </ul> </li> <li>3. Copies of most recent endoscopy and pathology reports.</li> <li>4. Labs or imaging already performed or determined necessary by the treating provider.</li> </ol>	<div style="background-color: red; color: black; text-align: center; padding: 5px;"><b>DEFER</b></div> <p>Submit the information to the FAA for a possible Special Issuance.</p> <p>Summarize elements or findings in Item 60.</p>
