It must include: A detailed summary of the history of the condition; Current medications, dosage, and side effects (if any); Physical exam findings; Results of any testing performed; Diagnosis; assessment and plan; Prognosis; and follow-up. 	Submit the information to the FAA for a possible Special Issuance. Annotate (elements or findings) in Item 60.
	 The Clinical Progress Note must specifically include: Current disease severity, GAP score, History of acute exacerbations or other complications Pulmonary Function Test (PFTs) with DLCO performed within the past 90 days Current 6-Minute Walk Test (6MWT) per FAA protocol Results of tests/ imaging already performed (such as High-Resolution CT or arterial blood gas).

Secondary Pulmonary fibrosis Due to a known cause (See corresponding page)	 Submit the following for FAA review: All Evaluation Data in Row A and Any information required for the underlying condition. 	DEFER Submit the information to the FAA for a possible Special Issuance. Annotate (elements or findings) in Item 60.
