Any history</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After the condition has fully resolved; • No symptoms remain; and • Medication is no longer needed for suppression of the vertigo: <p>Submit the following for FAA review:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A current, detailed Clinical Progress Note generated from a clinic visit with the treating otolaryngologist (ENT) or neurotologist no more than 90 days prior to the AME exam. It must include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A detailed summary of the history of the condition; • Current medications, dosage, and side effects (if any); • Physical exam findings; • Results of any testing performed; • Diagnosis; • Assessment and plan (prognosis); and • Follow-up 2. It must specifically include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If active disease exists. • If in remission, when did remission commence. 3. Current clinical audiogram with Air-Conduction/Bone-Conduction (AC/BC) and Speech Discrimination (SD) (performed within the past 90 days). 4. Additional tests such as [ECOG, VEMP, MRI with Gadolinium of the cerebellopontine angle (CPA), etc.] performed as clinically indicated. 5. All Office treatment records. 6. Pharmacy Records for the last 3 years from all Pharmacies used. 7.
