



Click the "Login" link

1. Place your cursor at the end of the “Federal Aviation Administration” under Institutional Login.
2. Hit Enter to initiate single sign on with FAA PIV card.
3. “Federal Aviation Administration” will drop down below, click on the drop-down line and press “Enter” on your computer keyboard.
4. Follow prompts/instructions for FAA login with PIV Card.



Once you complete the PIV login process, you'll be automatically directed to the SAE FAA subscription site.

You will know you are within the FAA subscription services when you see “ Provided by: Federal Aviation Administration.”
