- PURPOSE.** This advisory circular (AC) announces the availability of AC 150/5050-3B, Planning the State Aviation System.
- CANCELLATION.** AC 150/5050-3A, Planning the State Airport System, dated June 1972, is cancelled.
- BACKGROUND.** The information presented in AC 150/5050-3B is intended primarily for the use of state aviation agencies and their consultants. However, it may prove useful to other state and metropolitan/regional organizations involved in transportation and land use planning, budgetary/fiscal activities, and legislative matters. The individual airport operator and the general public may also find this document helpful. This AC provides national guidance for state airport-heliport system planning and may be used for this purpose pursuant to the provisions of the Airport and Airway Improvement Act of 1982, as amended by the Airport and Airway Safety and Capacity Expansion Act of 1987.
