The effective date of AC 150/5345-43J, *Specification for Obstruction Lighting Systems*, is extended by six months to September 11, 2020. After this date, only equipment qualified per the specification in AC 150/5345-43J, *Specification for Obstruction Lighting Systems*, will be listed in AC 150/5345-53D, *Airport Lighting Equipment Certification Program*.

This extension allows manufacturers additional time to design, test, and certify all associated obstruction lighting equipment to the new infrared specifications for LED obstruction lights.
