1. Purpose. This advisory circular (AC) transmits a *website* that contains Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Certificated Aviation Maintenance Technician Schools, which are certificated under the provisions of Title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations (14 CFR) part 147. The FAA Certificated Aviation Maintenance Technician Schools on the website meet the requirements of part 147, subpart B, Certification Requirements, for the ratings issued. FAA certification does not necessarily mean universities will extend college credit nor does it indicate approval by other states or federal agencies.
