Subject:	Cancellation of Advisory Circular 20-65A, U.S. Airworthiness Certificates and Authorizations for Operation of Domestic and Foreign Aircraft

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Purpose: This memorandum requests the cancellation of Advisory Circular (AC) 20-65A, U.S. Airworthiness Certificates and Authorizations for Operation of Domestic and Foreign Aircraft, dated July 8, 2004.

Background: This AC offers general information on issuing standard, special airworthiness certificates, and special flight permits for U.S.-registered aircraft, and special flight authorizations (SFA) for operating in the United States of foreign aircraft not having standard airworthiness certificates issued by the country of registry.

Discussion: AC 20-65A was intended to aid Production Approval Holders (PAHs) or individual owners of civil aircraft seeking to obtain an airworthiness certificate or a special flight authorization from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). The <u>FAA website</u>, <u>Airworthiness</u> <u>Certification page</u>, provides the guidance and information needed to prepare for the airworthiness certificates, special flight permits as well as detailed information on obtaining SFAs. Given this redundancy, AC 20-65A is no longer required.
