Subject: Cancellation of Advisory Circular 91-45C, Waivers: Aviation Events

Flight Standards Service is requesting the cancellation of Advisory Circular (AC) 91-45C, Waivers: Aviation Events, for reasons for the following reasons:

- AC 91-45C contains references to regulations that are no longer in existence (e.g. FAR 91.79(c)).
- The information in AC 91-45C is significantly outdated and conflicts with current FAA guidance.
 - o FAA Order 1320.46D, "FAA Advisory Circular System" states in part that out-of-date ACs should be "reviewed or removed from the AC system".
- AC 91-45C does not comply with 49 CFR part 5, "Administrative Rulemaking, Guidance, and Enforcement Procedures".
