Subject:	Cancellation of Advisory Circular (AC), Installation Approval on Transport Category Airplanes of Cargo Unit Load Devices Approved as Meeting the Criteria in NAS 3610

AIR-100 is requesting that AC 25-5, *Installation Approval on Transport Category Airplanes of Cargo Unit Load Devices Approved as Meeting the Criteria in NAS 3610*, dated 6/3/70, be cancelled.

AC 25-5 was issued to set forth an acceptable means, but not the sole means, of complying with the requirements applicable to the installation on transport category airplanes of cargo unit load devices approved as meeting the criteria in NAS 3610. The AC is obsolete and unnecessary. The information in the AC was overtaken by FAA Order 8110-4C.

Accordingly, please cancel AC 25-5 within the FAA Directives Management Information System.
