Subject: Cancellation of Advisory Circular 25.253-1A, High Speed Characteristics,
dated December 27, 1976

This memorandum cancels Advisory Circular (AC) 25.253-1A, High-Speed Characteristics, dated December 27, 1976.

Advisory Circular 25.253-1A was issued to describe an acceptable means of demonstrating compliance with Title 14, Code of Federal Regulations 25.253 during certification flight tests.

This AC is obsolete and unnecessary. All of the information in AC 25.253-1A was included in AC 25-7, Flight Test Guide for Certification of Transport Category Airplanes, when it was issued on April 9, 1980. However, we inadvertently neglected to cancel AC 25.253-1A at that time. We expect this action to have no effect on applicants or regulators because the content of this AC was included in AC 25-7.

The issuance of this memorandum cancels AC 25.253-1A.
