Purpose

This memorandum requests cancellation of AC 33-1B, Turbine Engine Foreign Object Ingestion and Rotor Blade Containment Type Certification Procedures, dated April 22, 1970. Since we issued AC 33-1B in 1970, we have introduced new requirements in 14 CFR part 33 and associated ACs since 1970 to address ingestion and containment issues. This AC is no longer applicable. There will be no impact to the budget from this cancellation.
