Subject: Cancellation of AC 90-111, Guidance for the Validation of Software Tools Used in

the Development of Instrument Flight Procedures by Third Party Service Providers

Please cancel Advisory Circular 90-111, Guidance for the Validation of Software Tools Used in the Development of Instrument Flight Procedures by Third Party Service Providers. This advisory circular (AC) provides guidance material for third party Instrument Flight Procedure (IFP) developers, hereafter referred to as "Service Providers," who use software based tools to develop Performance Based Navigation (PBN) Title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations (14 CFR) Part 97 Standard Instrument Procedures, to have these software tools validated by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

The responsibility to validate software resides with the Service Provider.
