Dear Industry Representative:

We are circulating Draft Change 2 of Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Advisory Circular (AC) 150/5200-30D, *Airport Field Condition Assessments and Winter Operations Safety*, to interested industry associations to obtain comments and recommendations of action.

The FAA recommends the guidelines contained in this Change, and we request your concurrence. The Change provides additional language and guidance to airport operators on snow removal around airport navigational aids and on when to issue new runway condition reports.

Please review this draft document and comment as appropriate. The Principal Changes paragraph in the Change 2 cover sheet identify the primary revisions, but we have also highlighted these changes in the text. Please note we are seeking comments on the changes only, not the entire AC.
