We are circulating Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Draft Advisory Circular (AC) 150/5220-9B, *Aircraft Arresting Systems on Civil Airports*, to interested industry associations to obtain comment and recommendations of action.

The FAA recommends the guidelines contained in this AC. This AC provides voluntary guidance for all airport operators for the installations of aircraft arresting systems on civil airports not owned or operated by the U.S. Department of Defense (DoD).
