We are circulating Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Draft Advisory Circular (AC) 150/5345-10H, "Specification for Constant Current Regulators" to interested industry associations to obtain comments and recommendations of actions to be taken. Please review this draft and submit comments as appropriate. Additionally, please provide justification for all comments about issues you may have with the draft and recommended modifications. We may revise the final document as a result of comments received and further review by the Office of Airport Safety and Standards.

This AC specifies the requirements for constant current regulators (CCR) and a monitor for use with airport lighting circuits.

We request concurrence with the enclosure. We will consider comments received by June 5, 2014, for inclusion in the advisory circular.
