We are circulating Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Draft Advisory Circular (AC) 150/5345-42H, *Specification for Airport Light Bases, Transformer Housings, Junction Boxes, and Accessories*, to interested industry associations to obtain comments and recommendations.
