Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Draft Advisory Circular (AC) 150/5220-17B, *Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) Training Facilities*, is being circulated to interested industry associations to obtain comments and recommendations of actions to be taken.

This AC provides guidance on the design, construction, and operation of ARFF training facilities. This AC contains information on facilities that are both permanent and mobile, and utilize a flammable liquid hydrocarbon (FLH) or propane as a fuel.

Please review this draft and submit comments as appropriate. Comments should be submitted on a separate document, and not embedded in the draft AC. Additionally, please provide justification for all comments regarding oppositions and recommended modifications. The final version of the AC may be revised as a result of comments received and further review by the Office of Airport Safety and Standards.
