We are requesting your review of AC 150/5300-18B Change 1, General Guidance and Specifications for Submission of Aeronautical Surveys to NGS: Field Data Collection and Geographic Information System (GIS) Standards.

The primary purpose of this change 1 is to clarify the instructions and understanding of how the system is working now. These changes are the result of help desk inquiries and conversations related to understanding what the standard is and to reduce multiple interpretations of the language. This change also includes clarifications and minor adjustments of line weight and symbols to align with national computer-aided design (CAD) standards.

Please review this draft and submit comments as appropriate on the provided **Comments Matrix**. Include paragraph references and justification for all comments on this Matrix. We may revise the final document as a result of comments received and further review by the Office of Airport Safety and Standards.
