SUBJ: FAA International Governance Structure

- **1. Purpose of this Notice.** This notice advises stakeholders of modifications to the international governance structure previously established in FAA Order 1240.15, *FAA International Governance Structure and Technical Assistance Request Process.*
- **2.** Audience. All FAA Lines of Business/Staff Offices (LOB/SOs) involved in international activities.

- **4. Explanation of Policy Changes.** On December 8, 2021, the Administrator and the FAA Management Board agreed to establish a tiered governance structure to increase exposure, data-informed decision-making, and communication on international topics by senior agency leadership. The new structure supersedes the previous international governance structure established in 2017 by Order 1240.15.
- **5. International Governance.** This notice formalizes the following agency-wide international governance structure:
 - **a.** It is anticipated that the International Steering Committee (ISC) will continue as a communication, information sharing, and coordination body. The ISC is not a decision-making body within the governance structure. The structure, composition, and function of the ISC will be addressed in a separate document.
 - **b.** The International Governance Board (IGB) replaces the current International Advisory Board (IAB). The Executive Director, Office of International Affairs (API-1) and supporting API personnel serve as the IGB Secretariat. The IGB is a decision-making body within the governance structure, but only in accordance with new criteria. Those criteria and the structure, composition, and function of the IGB will be addressed in a separate document.
 - **c.** The IGB will forward matters to the FAA Deputies Board, which will serve as the senior decision-making body for international matters, in accordance with the criteria referenced in subparagraph 5.b.

- **d.** The FAA Deputies Board will forward unresolved international matters to the Administrator and the FAA Management Board for resolution.
- 6. Actions. All LOB/SOs must:
 - **a.** Nomenclature. Replace references to the IAB with IGB references in their affected directives or other documents.
 - **b. Integration.** Collaborate through various means (e.g., International Community of Interest (ICOI)) to support data-informed decision-making within the international governance structure.
- 7. Distribution. This notice should be distributed to all LOB/SOs that are directly involved with the agency's international activities.
