SUBJ: Air Traffic Currency Requirements

- 1. Purpose of This Notice.** This notice amends Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Order JO 7210.3, Paragraph 2-3-1, General, to reinforce the requirement that facility managers are responsible for monitoring and tracking currency for those employees who are required to maintain currency. The change is intended to ensure consistent compliance in all air traffic facilities.
- 2. Audience.** This notice applies to the following Air Traffic Organization (ATO) service units: En Route and Oceanic, Terminal, and System Operations; and all associated air traffic control facilities.

- 4. Cancellation.** This notice cancels N JO 7210.805, Air Traffic Currency Requirements for En Route Facilities, effective February 11, 2012.
- 5. Procedures.** Amend paragraph 2-3-1 to read as follows:
 - 2-3-1. GENERAL**
 - a.** It must be the responsibility of the employees identified in Paragraph 2-3-2, Application, to adhere to the requirements of this section.
 - b.** Facility managers must develop procedures for the tracking and reporting currency for those employees identified in subparagraph 2-3-2b.
- 6. Distribution.** This notice is distributed to the following ATO service units: Terminal, En Route and Oceanic, System Operations, and Mission Support; the Office of ATO Safety and Technical Training; and the Air Traffic Safety Oversight Service.
- 7. Background.** This change reinforces the current requirement that employees who are required to maintain currency have a personal responsibility to adhere to the requirements specified in FAA Order JO 7210.3 regarding currency requirements.
