#### SUBJ: Flight Data Center (FDC) Presidential, Special Security Instructions, or Emergency Air Traffic Rules and Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFR)

**1. Purpose of This Notice**. This notice addresses air traffic Notices to Airmen (NOTAM) procedures associated with FDC Presidential, Special Security Instructions, or Emergency Air Traffic Rules and TFRs.

**2.** Audience. This notice applies to En Route and Oceanic, Terminal, and System Operations Services; the service centers; and air traffic field offices and facilities.

**3.** Where Can I Find This Notice? This notice is available on MYFAA employee Web site at https://employees.faa.gov/tools\_resources/orders\_notices/ and on the air traffic publications Web site at http://www.faa.gov/airports\_airtraffic/air\_traffic/publications.

#### 4. Procedures.

**a.** Amend Federal Aviation Administration Order 7930.2K, Notices to Airmen (NOTAM), Paragraph 3-1-4, FDC Presidential, Special Security Instructions, or Emergency Air Traffic Rules TFRs, to read as follows:

# **3-1-4. FDC PRESIDENTIAL, SPECIAL SECURITY INSTRUCTIONS, OR EMERGENCY AIR TRAFFIC RULES TFRS**

Subparagraphs a through e – no change.

f. The FAA and the National Association of Air Traffic Specialists (NAATS) have issued a memorandum of agreement to supplement this procedure.

1. As part of the flight service station (FSS) supervisor's watch checklist, the watch supervisor shall check the FDC list that is issued twice a day by the USNOF to ensure that every Presidential, Special Security Instructions, or Emergency Air Traffic Rules FDC NOTAM has been received in the facility.

2. If no supervisory personnel are on duty and a controller-in-charge (CIC) is assigned to these duties, emergency situations, and/or in-flight services as defined in FAA Order (FAAO) 7110.10 shall take precedence over compliance with the supervisory duties contained in this paragraph.

#### NOTE-

The purpose of this procedure is to ensure that:

1. All flight service specialists know about the Presidential, Special Security Instructions, or Emergency Air Traffic Rules TFRs so that pilots are briefed appropriately.

2. All affected air traffic facilities receive immediate notification when these TFRs are issued.

**b**. Amend Paragraph 7-1-5, Temporary Flight Restrictions, to read as follows:

#### 7-1-5. TEMPORARY FLIGHT RESTRICTIONS

Disaster areas are designated by the appropriate air route traffic control center (ARTCC). The ARTCC shall forward the NOTAM information directly to the USNOF [(703) 904-4557 or 1-888-USNOTAM (876-6826)] for FDC NOTAM issuance. The USNOF shall make FDC NOTAM dissemination, and the FSS shall act as "coordination facility" for preflight briefings for the ARTCC. The NOTAM shall contain:

 Designate the ATO Security Coordinator at (202) 267-3333 as the coordination facility, or a designated ATC

 facility.

**5. Distribution**. This notice is distributed to the following ATO service units: En Route and Oceanic, Terminal, Safety, and System Operations Services; the service centers; the Air Traffic Safety Oversight Service; the William J. Hughes Technical Center; the Mike Monroney Aeronautical Center and air traffic field offices and facilities.

**6. Background**. With Lockheed Martin now the contractor for FSSs, except in Alaska, Lockheed Martin's responsibilities have been realigned. The act of notifying other ATC facilities was removed from the contract and this scope was realigned to another organization within the ATO. These procedures were in a previous general notice, but were not published. These changes will not affect any FSSs or automated flight service stations in Alaska.

**7. Implementation**. This notice shall be implemented on the effective date and the content of this notice will be incorporated into FAAO 7930.2K, change 2, effective August 30, 2007.
