- 1. Purpose of this Notice.** This notice renames the Office of Emergency Operations, Communications, and Investigations (AEO) to the Office of National Security Programs and Incident Response (AEO) within the Office of Security and Hazardous Materials Safety (ASH).
- 2. Who this affects.** The name change impacts internal Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) organizations and external entities that interact with AEO.
- 3. - 4. Explanation of changes.** The mission of the Office of National Security Programs and Incident Response continues to grow and evolve. The prior office name no longer captures the expanse of the work, roles, and responsibilities of AEO. The new name more accurately identifies AEO's mission within ASH and the FAA, as well as simplifies the moniker. The three letter organization designator (AEO) will remain unchanged.
- 5. Functions.** There are no changes to the functions of AEO.
- 6. Organization chart.** The Office of Security and Hazardous Materials Safety Organization Chart is attached as Appendix A.
- 7. Distribution.** This notice is distributed at the office level within the Office of Security and Hazardous Materials Safety. An informational copy will be provided to all FAA Associate and Assistant Administrators.
