Subject: Cancellation of Notice N 8900.608, Relocation of Guidance on Required Inspection Items (RII) in FAA Order 8900.1

Overview: The Aircraft Maintenance Division (AFS-300) is requesting the immediate cancellation of Notice N 8900.608, *Relocation of Guidance on Required Inspection Items (RII) in FAA Order 8900.1*.

N 8900.608 established a 6-month timeframe for corrective actions regarding Require Inspection Items (RII) procedures. Field input and concerns revealed the timeframe was too restrictive and needed to be removed. Specifically, limited resources and concerns from field offices are affecting the ability of field offices and certificate holders to meet the timeframe imposed by N 8900.608. A revised Notice is already in work that will replace N 8900.608 and address the issue.
