SUBJ: Amendment to the Effective Date of FAA Order JO 7110.10X

- **1. Purpose of This Notice**. This notice amends Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Order JO 7110.10X, Flight Services, effective date, due to the government shutdown.
- **2. Audience**. This notice applies to the following Air Traffic Organization (ATO) service units: Air Traffic Services, Mission Support, and System Operations; and all associated air traffic control facilities.
- **3. Where Can I Find This Notice**? This notice is available on the MyFAA employee Web site at https://employees.faa.gov/tools_resources/orders_notices/ and on the air traffic publications Web site at http://www.faa.gov/air_traffic/publications/.
- **4. Procedures**. Amend the effective date of FAA Order 7110.10X, Flight Services, to April 3, 2014.
- **5. Distribution**. This notice is distributed to the following ATO service units: Air Traffic Services, Mission Support, and System Operations; the Office of ATO Safety and Technical Training; the Air Traffic Safety Oversight Service; the William J. Hughes Technical Center; and the Mike Monroney Aeronautical Center.
- **6. Background**. The standard processing time required for this air traffic directive was negatively impacted by the government shutdown in October. The spring publication cycle requires the full six months of preparation. Due to the shutdown, the annual holiday season work moratorium, and the contractual obligation to provide changes to the workforce 30 days prior to implementation for appropriate training, the new effective date is pushed back to April 3, 2014.
