SUBJ: PIREP Solicitation and Dissemination

- 1. Purpose of This Notice.** This notice clarifies the front line manager/controller-in-charge (FLM/CIC) options for disseminating significant PIREPs.
- 2. Audience.** This notice applies to the following Air Traffic Organization (ATO) service units: Air Traffic Services, Mission Support, System Operations, Safety and Technical Training; and all associated air traffic facilities.
- 3. Where Can I Find This Notice?** This notice is available on the MyFAA employee website at https://employees.faa.gov/tools_resources/orders_notices/ and on the air traffic publications website at http://www.faa.gov/air_traffic/publications/.
- 4. Procedures.** Amend FAA Order JO 7110.65, paragraph 2-6-2, PIREP Solicitation and Dissemination, to read as follows:
 - 2-6-2. PIREP SOLICITATION AND DISSEMINATION**

Title thru d 3 (a) No change

 - (b) The FLM/CIC for long-line dissemination via an FAA approved electronic system (for example, AIS-R, or similar systems); or,
 - (c) Outside Alaska: The overlying ARTCC's Flight Data Unit for long-line dissemination.
 - (d) Alaska Only: The FSS serving the area in which the report was obtained.

No further changes to paragraph.
- 5. Distribution.** This notice is distributed to the following ATO service units: Air Traffic Services, Mission Support, System Operations, Safety and Technical Training; the Air Traffic Safety Oversight Service; and the William J. Hughes Technical Center.
- 6. Background.** The recent publication of FAA Order JO 7110.65X, paragraph 2-6-2, PIREP Solicitation and Dissemination, was inadvertently published with the word "or" incorrectly placed within the subparagraphs of 2-6-2 d.3.c. and d. This has caused FLM/CIC to believe that they are required to enter the PIREP in AIS-R as well as forwarding the PIREP to the overlying ARTCC's Flight Data Unit. The intent was to allow dissemination by either a AIS-R entry or by forward the PIREP to the overlying ARTCC's Flight Data Unit.
