SUBJ: Currency for Operations Supervisor/Supervisory Traffic Management Coordinator/National Traffic Management Officer (OS/STMC/NTMO)

1. Purpose of This Notice. This notice changes FAA Order JO 7210.3DD, Facility Operation and Administration, paragraph 2-3-3, Requirements, regarding supervisory currency.

2. Audience. All operational personnel assigned to Air Traffic Services (AJT) and System Operations Services (AJR) facilities.

3. Where Can I Find This Notice? This notice is available on the MyFAA employee website at https://employees.faa.gov/tools_resources/orders_notices/ and on the air traffic publications website at http://www.faa.gov/air_traffic/publications/.

4. Explanation of Policy Change. This change modifies policy to allow an Operations Supervisor, Supervisory Traffic Management Coordinator, or National Traffic Management Officer (OS/STMC/NTMO) when responsible for the position, to include time performing on-the-job-training (OJT), performance assessments (PA), and certification skill checks (CSC) to count towards operational/control position currency. No changes have been made regarding currency requirements for Air Traffic Control Specialists.

5. Action. Amend FAA Order JO 7210.3DD by changing the following paragraphs to read as follows:

2-3-3. REQUIREMENTS

Title through subparagraph b.2 No change

3. ATCS/TMC/NTMS – Time spent performing on-the-job-training (OJT) instruction is not counted toward operational/control position currency. Time spent responsible for a position where a certification skill check (CSC) or performance assessment (PA) is being performed is not counted toward operational/control position currency.

Subparagraph b.4 No change

5. OS/STMC/NTMO – When the OS/STMC/NTMO is responsible for the position, time spent performing on-the-job training (OJT), certification skill checks (CSC), and performance assessments (PA) may account for no more than 50% of the time required for operational/control position currency.

No further changes to paragraph

6. Distribution. This notice is distributed to the following ATO service units: Air Traffic Services, Mission Support Services, System Operations Services, and Safety and Technical Training; the

7. Background. Currently, time used by an Operations Supervisor, Supervisory Traffic Management Coordinator, and National Traffic Management Officer (OS/STMC/NTMO) conducting on-the-job-training (OJT), performance assessments (PA), and/or certification skill checks (CSC) does not count toward operational/control position currency.
