
**SUBJ:** Flight Standards Designation and Geographic Area Assignments

---

1. **Purpose.** This change transmits revised pages to FAA Order EA FS 1100.34H, Flight Standards Designation and Geographic Area Assignments.
2. **Audience.** This order applies to AFS division and branch managers in Headquarters and Regional Offices, all employees in the Eastern Region Flight Standards field offices, the Regional Administrators in Eastern, New England, Southern and Western-Pacific Regions, and all employees in the Air Traffic Eastern Service Center.

4. **Explanation of Changes.** Consolidated the London and Frankfurt IFOs in Frankfurt, Germany. Assigned the New York IFO as an international field unit in the New York FSDO and condensed language describing jurisdictional responsibilities. Pittsburgh CMO is no longer included within the Western-Pacific Region. Condensed the language referencing jurisdictional responsibilities for Rochester FSDO.
5. **Disposition of Transmittal Paragraph.** Retain this transmittal until superseded by a new basic order.

**SUBJ:** Flight Standards Designation and Geographic Area Assignments

**1. Purpose of this Order:** This order revises the Eastern Region Flight Standards District Offices (FSDOs), Certificate Management Office (CMO) and International Field Offices (IFOs), designation and geographic areas of responsibility.

**2. Audience:** This order is distributed to AFS division and branch managers in Headquarters and regional offices, all FSDOs in Eastern, Southern and Western-Pacific Regions, all Eastern Region Flight Standards IFOs, the Eastern, Western and Central Service Centers and all Air Traffic field facilities in the Eastern and Western Service Centers.

**4. Cancellation:** Order EA FS 1100.34G dated August 23, 1999, is cancelled.


**5. Explanation of Changes:**

a. Eastern Region Flight Standards Division realigned with New England Region, adding four additional offices (Boston, Windsor Locks, Portland and the Boston Aircraft Evaluation Group). Aviation matters associated with the Flight Standards offices in New England Region are under the purview of the New England Regional Administrator, ANE-1, and the Flight Standards Division Manager, AEA-200. This includes activities associated with emergency planning and preparedness and the continuity of operations plan (COOP).

b. Eastern Region also gained two offices from Southern Region (Greensboro and Charlotte). Aviation matters associated with the Flight Standards offices in Southern Region are under the purview of the Southern Regional Administrator, ASO-1, and the Flight Standards Division Manager, AEA-200. This includes activities associated with emergency planning and preparedness and the COOP.

c. With the US Airways and AmericaWest merger, the CMOs for those airlines merged. The US Airways CMO is located in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and a contingency of employees is located in Phoenix, Arizona. Any regional matters affecting the U.S. Airway's CMO office located in Phoenix, Arizona, shall be communicated from the Western-Pacific Regional Administrator, AWP-1 to the Eastern Region Flight Standards Division Manager, AEA-200. This includes FAA staff activities associated with emergency planning and preparedness and response.

d. Appendix 1. Revised Appendix 1 to include new FSDOs, change in office designations and changes in geographic areas of responsibility.
