SUBJ: REIMBURSABLE RATES FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL DETAILED TO FAA

1. PURPOSE. This order prescribes reimbursable rates for military personnel detailed to FAA.
2. DISTRIBUTION. This order is distributed to regions, centers, and Washington offices involved in the formulation of budget/program estimates, the administration of program activities, or the utilization of agency resources, as contained in the ZBU-323 list.
3. CANCELLATION. Order 2500.28R, undated, is canceled.
4. EXPLANATION OF CHANGES. The composite standard military rates in appendix 1 are revised to reflect the new annual Department of Defense pay rates which became effective October 1, 1985. A new appendix 2, Basic Allowance for Quarters, and appendix 3, Permanent Change of Station Expense Rates, are included to reflect amounts incorporated in the appendix 1 rates for each of these elements of expense. Acceleration factors covering the costs of military personnel benefits not included in the appendix 1 standard rates are below in paragraph 5.
5. APPLICATION. The composite standard rates in appendix 1 represent the basic annual rates of reimbursement payable to the DOD for military personnel detailed to the FAA. To these amounts must be added the following appropriate acceleration factors for the accrual of leave, holiday, and other personnel costs which are not included in the composite standard rates:
 - a. Multiply each appropriate composite standard rate by 1.14 to arrive at a standard rate accelerated by the leave and holiday factor of 14 percent.
 - b. Multiply the product in paragraph 5 by 1.06 for officers or 1.18 for enlisted personnel to arrive at a standard rate accelerated by both the leave and holiday factor and the other personnel costs factors of 6 percent or 18 percent respectively.
