The Office of Aerospace Medicine (AAM) would like to cancel The Health Awareness Program (HAP) Order (3900.53A).

AAM has discontinued national oversight for the Health Awareness Program and there is no plan to resurrect national oversight in the future. In the absence of national oversight the HAP is no longer necessary. Canceling the order would not preclude Regional Flight Surgeons from continuing initiatives to provide health information to regional employees.

Because the order is no longer necessary and serves no meaningful purpose, AAM requests that the order be canceled immediately.
