Subject: Request to cancel legacy FAA Information Technology Security & Privacy orders and Policies

I hereby request cancellation of Several Information Technology Orders and Policies due to the recent approval of the FAA Information Security and Privacy Program & Policy, 1370.121 which are now no longer in effect due to newer technology usage and contract expiration. The two orders and policies below are both remnants of a legacy Office Automation Technology and Services (OATS) contract which is no longer in effect. These orders and policies require removal from the Agency registry and should be rescinded. The orders and policies which were for the OATS contract and should be removed from the registry include:
