The NextGen Organization requests approval to cancel FAA William J. Hughes Technical Center Order CT 4650.1D, Control of Government Furnished Property in the Custody of FAA William J. Hughes Technical Center Contractors dated October 12, 2004 without replacement.

Background:


The purpose of this order was to establish procedures and guidelines for the review, accountability, financial accounting, disposition, and contractor's use of Government Furnished Property (GFP) provided by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) or acquired by the contractor under performance of a FAA William J. Hughes Technical Center (Technical Center) executed contract. It also included procedures controlling Technical Center GFP provided by the FAA to contractors whose contracts are executed by the Washington procurement office.

Rationale and Safety Risk Management (SRM) Assessment:

In 2008, the Acquisition and Grants Division was straight lined to Washington Headquarters Acquisitions (AFN). The Acquisition and Grants Division is now a part of ACQ - Acquisition and Business Services. The responsibility for this order no longer resides in what was ACX (now ANG). All current orders and regulations for acquisitions reside in FAA Headquarters and address both Headquarters and the Technical Center. This order should have been cancelled at the time that the division was realigned with Headquarters. Cancelling this policy will not negatively affect the safety of the National Aerospace System (NAS).

After reviewing the above assessment, I (We), the undersigned, concur the cancellation of the Order CT 4650.1D without replacement will not negatively affect the safety of the NAS.




