



AJW-23 requests concurrence on the cancellation of FAA Order SO Airway Facilities (AF) 3900.27, Southern Region Confined Space Program, dated July 31, 2000. The subject order prescribes procedures and assigns responsibilities within AF for the implementation of a confined space program.

The Eastern Service Area EOSH Technical Service Center, on behalf of the legacy organization, confirms that the order will not be updated and therefore does not object to its cancellation.


