Subject: 7100.9E Standard Terminal Arrival (STAR) Program and Procedures

The purpose of this memorandum is to request that you cancel FAA Order 7100.9E, Standard Terminal Arrival (STAR) Program and Procedures.

The 7100.9E previously covered both Performance Based Navigation (PBN) criteria and policy guidance. In an effort to align the content of the order with the appropriate authority, the portions that cover policy and processes are now included in the FAA JO 7100.41A, PBN Implementation Process.

All portions of the 7100.9E that address criteria related to STAR Obstacle Evaluation Area (OEA) construction and documentation have been incorporated into the following FAA Order 8260-series: Order 8260.19G, Flight Procedures and Airspace, Order 8260.3C, United States Standard for Terminal Instrument Procedures (TERPS), and Order 8260.58A, the United States Standard for PBN Instrument Procedure Design.
