





Subject: Cancellation Request for FAA Order 7450.1, Special Use Airspace Management  
System (SAMS)

---

FAA Order 7450.1, *Special Use Airspace Management System*, was originally managed by the Military Operations and Procedures Branch (ATO-130) and then the Special Operations Division (ATP-200). This office was subsumed, as part of creation of the Air Traffic Organization (ATO), by System Operations Security (AJR-2) in 2004.

Approximately 9 years ago, AJR-2 relinquished the responsibility for and management of the technical aspects of the Special Use Airspace Management System (SAMS) program. Since then, the technical aspects of the SAMS program has been moved to Enterprise Services (AJM-3) within the Program Management Organization while issues associated with the use of SAMS are handled by Mission Support (AJV) and Air Traffic Services (AJT).

Pursuant to recent discussions with AJM-33 and select offices within AJV and AJT, there appears to be no continuing need for this Order. Nor have these offices accepted the responsibility for updating this Order. Therefore, AJR-2 requests that FAA Order 7450.1 be cancelled.
