7110.82D	06/03/2009	Reporting Oceanic Errors	AFS-400	The Air Traffic Organization (ATO) Safety and Technical Training (AJI) published Change 1, to FAA Order JO 7210.632, Air Traffic Organization Occurrence Reporting, with an effective date of February 27, 2020. JO 7210.632 now specifically addresses reporting of safety occurrences that happen in oceanic airspace. The ATO plans further enhancements to oceanic reporting in the Comprehensive Electronic Data Analysis and Reporting (CEDAR) tool so cancellation of FAA Order 7110.82 may take effect on <u>July 30, 2020</u> .
