In Response to the Western Service Area Directives Revalidation Action, the following is our request to cancel the following legacy regional quality assurance orders within the Western Service Area:

WP AT 7210.6C, Air Traffic Quality Assurance (QA) Program, effective 12/31/2011

WP AT 7210.24, Western Terminal Operations Area Quality Assurance Special Emphasis Items, effective 10/18/2004

NM 7210.9A, Quality Assurance Order, Effective 8/26/1998

Rationale for not requiring further SRM analysis:

There are no personnel or organizations that use these directives, so none are impacted by cancellations of these documents. None of these directives are being used nor are there any plans under which we foresee that they could be used in the future. So the cancellations of the orders identified in this SRMDM do not impact NAS safety.


