SUBJ: FAA Blood Donor Program

1. Purpose of This Order. This order prescribes assigned responsibility for the FAA Blood Donor Program within FAA Headquarter offices and services.

2. Who This Order Affects. All FAA Headquarter employees in the District of Columbia.

4. What This Order Cancels. FAA Order 3900.1C, FAA Blood Donor Program, is cancelled.

5. Explanation of Policy Changes. This revision updates language used to describe the responsibilities of the Blood Donor Chief Recruiter.

6. Responsibilities. The FAA Headquarters Blood Donor Chief Recruiter will provide necessary coordination with the service provider, and advice and assistance to organizational contacts and employees on any problems encountered.

7. Employee Participation. The FAA encourages physically qualified employees to give this program their full support by donating blood. Patients in our health care system critically need blood and blood products.
