SUBJ: ELIMINATION OF OUTER DOORS ON HEVI-DUTY, THREE PHASE,
ALSAF REGULATOR SUBSTATIONS

1. PURPOSE. This Order permits the removal of the outer doors to the common control, meter, and regulator, numbers 1, 2, and 3 control panels of the Hevi-Duty, three-phase, ALSAF substations. The outer doors are shown in Figure 9, page 30 of Hevi-Duty Instruction Book, Part #51330.
2. DISTRIBUTION. This Order is distributed to the Airway Facilities Division, Branch level and above, and to all Airway Facilities field offices.
3. CANCELLATION. Order CE SM 6910.11 is cancelled.
4. BACKGROUND. The weatherproof outer doors were provided with the original regulator substation which was not equipped with a walk-in, metal clad housing. The later addition of housings eliminated the need for the doors. Subsequent experience in the limited housing space has indicated that the doors are a safety hazard to workmen and can be eliminated without any deleterious effects to the maintenance and operation of the Approach Lighting Systems.
5. APPLICATION. Local maintenance personnel may remove the doors to the regulator compartments enumerated in Paragraph 1 and which are now on the interior of the metal housings attached to the substation.
6. AUTHORIZATION. Washington authorized the removal of the above mentioned doors.
