**SUBJ: INTRA REGIONAL COORDINATION FOR OBTAINING LOCATION IDENTIFIERS
FOR NEW FACILITIES**

1. PURPOSE. This Order establishes Regional responsibilities for obtaining new facility identifiers, frequencies, and/or names.
2. DISTRIBUTION. This Order is distributed to the Airway Facilities, Air Traffic, Flight Standards, and Logistics Division, Branch level and above in the Regional Office, and to all Air Traffic, Airway Facilities and Flight Standards field offices and facilities.
3. RELATED DOCUMENTS. Handbook 7350.4D, "Location Identifiers", Handbook 6000.5, "Facilities Master File"; Order 7470.1B, "Processing Applications for Establishment of Non-Federal Facilities.
4. ACTION.
 - a. New Facilities and Equipment Navigational Aids
 - (1) As soon as approved NAVAID projects are received from Washington, Airway Facilities, Programs and Planning Branch (AGL-425) will provide information required in items 2 thru 6, 8, and 10a, of Form GL 7350., Appendix 1 of this Order, and forward it to Airway Facilities, Frequency Management and Leased Communications Staff (AGL-406).
 - (2) AGL-406 will take action to reserve a frequency, (items 7 and 9) and forward it to Air Traffic, Airspace and Procedures Branch (AGL-530).
 - (3) AGL-530 will supply information for item 1, 10b and 11, and forward request to Air Traffic, Cartographic and Technical Standards Branch (AAT-420) in Washington.
 - (4) Upon receipt of approved identifier and/or name from AAT-420, AGL-530 will forward this information to Flight Standards, Flight Inspection and Procedures Branch (AGL-220) and AGL-420 who will inform their branches and staffs.


b. New Non-NAVAID Facilities

- (1) Use the location identifier already approved for that location and listed in Handbook 7350.4B, or;
- (2) If no national identifier has been assigned, nor required by Air Traffic Service, then an identifier will be assigned by AGL-406 in accordance with GL Supplement to Handbook 6000.5, Appendix 1, Section 1.b.

c. New Non Federal Facilities

- (1) Concurrent with the request for Airspace Study, Airway Facilities, Electronic Engineering Branch (AGL-432) will provide information required in items 2 thru 6, 8, and 10a, of Form GL 7350.- and forward it to AGL-406.
- (2) AGL-406 will take action to reserve a frequency, (items 7 and 9) and forward it to AGL-530.
- (3) AGL-530 will supply information for item 1, 10b and 11, and forward request to AAT-420.
- (4) Upon receipt of approved identifier and/or name from AAT-420 , AGL-530 will forward this information to AGL-220 and AGL-432 who will inform their branches and staffs.
