SUBJ: PROCESSING APPLICATIONS FOR ESTABLISHMENT
OF NON-FEDERAL FACILITIES


1. PURPOSE. This Order establishes responsibilities and procedures in processing requests for new non-Federal aids to air navigation facilities.
2. DISTRIBUTION. This Order is being distributed in the Great Lakes Region to Branch level, all Air Traffic and Airway Facilities field facilities, Air Carrier District Offices (ACDOs), General Aviation District Offices (GADOs), Airport District Offices (ADOs), and Flight Inspection Field Offices (FIFOs).
3. CANCELLATION. Order GL 7470.1B dated 4/3/73 is cancelled.
4. POLICY. The Federal Aviation Administration recognizes the need for navigational facilities serving communities that may or may not meet FAA planning standards. The FAA will assist the proponent in the establishment of these facilities and, when requested, develop instrument approach procedures based upon the facilities.
5. PROCEDURES.
 - a. All requests to establish new non-Federal navigation aids received by any office shall be directed to the Airway Facilities Division, AGL-400.
 - b. The non-Federal specialist (AGL-432) will be the coordinator between the proponent and the FAA Divisions concerned.
 - c. No response indicating approval or disapproval shall be made to the proponent until the following actions have been completed.
 - (1) AGL-430 determines if a frequency is available and reserves a frequency.
 - (2) In the event the proposed facility is to support an instrument approach procedure, AGL-432, will provide AGL-220 the necessary documentation so a determination can be made as to eligibility requirements specified in Handbook 8260.3B.
 - (3) The Airspace and Procedures Branch, AGL-530, will determine Air Traffic Control and communications capabilities.
