PROCESSING WAIVERS OF PART 91 SUBPART B  
**SUBJ:** OF THE FEDERAL AVIATION REGULATIONS (FARs)

---

1. **PURPOSE.** This Order redelegates authority and responsibility for processing waivers of Part 91 Subpart B of the Federal Aviation Regulations (FARs).
2. **DISTRIBUTION.** This Order is distributed to Air Traffic branches and all Air Traffic field facilities in the Great Lakes Region.
3. **AUTHORITY.** Pursuant to the provisions of Order 7711.1, Policy and Procedures for Processing Waivers of Subpart B, Part 91 of the Federal Aviation Regulations, authority to grant or deny waivers to FAR Part 91 Subpart B is delegated to the Chief, Air Traffic Division, AGL-500, and Part 91 Subpart B, Section 91.109 and 91.121, is redelegated to the Chiefs of the Air Route Traffic Control Centers (ARTCCs).
4. **ACTION.**
  - a. As this Order redelegates authority for waivers of Part 91 Subpart B to ARTCC Chiefs, all Air Traffic facilities receiving requests and applications for waivers shall forward them to the ARTCC having jurisdiction over the area of operation.
  - b. ARTCCs shall process requests and applications of waivers in accordance with instructions set forth in Order 7711.1.
  - c. When a proposed operation is to be conducted within the airspace under one ARTCC's jurisdiction and airspace of an adjacent ARTCC, the Center Chief receiving the application shall coordinate and process the waiver. However, if the airspace of more than two adjacent ARTCCs or of another Region is affected by the proposed operation, or when the Center Chief determines that the nature and scope of the operation are such that action at a higher level is in the best interest of all concerned, the application for waiver shall be forwarded to AGL-500, ATTN: Airspace and Procedures Branch, AGL-530. The application should be accompanied with pertinent facts, documents and recommendations.

- d. Copies of waivers issued by ARTCC facilities shall be forwarded to AGL-530 and to the Chief, Airspace and Air Traffic Rules Division, AAT-200. Further distribution of copies shall be limited to those elements which have a need for the information.
