

SUBJ: GREAT LAKES REGION AIRWAY FACILITIES DIVISION LINE OF SUCCESSION

1. **PURPOSE.** This order prescribes a line of succession for contiguous executive direction of the Airway Facilities Division in the absence of the Division Manager.
2. **DISTRIBUTION.** This order is distributed to all Great Lakes Region divisions and staff offices, branch level and above in the Airway Facilities Division, and to all Airway Facilities field offices.
3. **CANCELLATION.** Order GL AF 1100.1D, Great Lakes Region Airway Facilities Division Line of Succession dated August 1, 1995, is canceled.
4. **SUCCESSION.** During the absence of the Division Manager from the regional office, the permanently assigned incumbents of positions shown below in the succession indicated, are designated as Acting Division Manager. Incumbents of these positions, while in acting status, are authorized to perform all functions delegated to the Division Manager.
 - a. Assistant Manager, Airway Facilities Division, AGL-401
 - b. Special Assistant, Airway Facilities Division, AGL-403
 - c. Manager, Resource Management Branch, AGL-420
 - d. Manager, Operations Branch, AGL-470
 - e. Manager, Executive Staff, AGL-410
5. **IMPLEMENTATION.** In the absence of the Division Manager, the incumbent of the first position listed above will automatically become Acting Division Manager. If the incumbent of the first position is absent, the next in the line of succession will assume the Acting Division Manager.
6. **TIME FRAME.** Any branch/staff manager having assumed the Acting Division Manager position under the terms and delegated authority of this order shall continue in that capacity until the Division Manager or Assistant Division Manager returns.
