SUBJ: Alaska Flight Services Information Area Group Line of Succession During
Emergency Situations

1. Purpose of This Order. This order defines Alaska Flight Services Information Area Group (AFSIAG) lines of authority to ensure continuity of management during a national emergency.

2. Who This Order Affects. This order affects all Alaska Flight Service Area AFSS/FSS facilities and AFSIAG.

3. Cancellation. Order AL 1910.4B, Alaska Flight Services Information Office Line of Succession During Emergency Situations, dated July 5, 2006 is cancelled.

4. Procedures. The AFSIAG lines of succession shall be as follows:

Manager, Alaska Flight Services

Manager, Operations and Program Support, AFSIAG

Manager, Fairbanks Automated Flight Service Station

Should the AFSIAG become incapacitated and/or unable to communicate during national emergencies, the next position on the list shall take over leadership of the Alaska Flight Service Area. Similarly, when any other person in the line of succession becomes incapacitated, the next person in line shall assume the authority.
