

Subject: Request to Cancel FAA Financial Orders

I hereby request cancellation of the following FAA Financial Orders:

Order 2400.11	FAA Involvement with the DOT Working Capital Fund
Order 2500.52	Testimony Before Appropriations Subcommittees
Order 2510.5A	Fiscal Programming and Reporting Procedures for the Facilities & Equipment Appropriation

To meet the FAA's long-term goal of keeping directives current, the Office of Budget & Programs carefully reviewed the orders and determined their need and purpose no longer exists. They have been incorporated into the FAA Financial Manual per FAA National Policy Order 1320.1E (*FAA Directives Management*, February 7, 2007).

Additionally, I request cancellation of FAA Order 2500.47A (*Evaluation of Budget Programs and Activities*, April 5, 1991). The policies and standards prescribed in this order are no longer valid. The function and the division assigned to carryout said function no longer exist in the Office of Budget and Programs.
