**SUBJ:** FAA Standard Subject Classification System

---

This order prescribes the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Standard Subject Classification System used in classifying correspondence, directives, files, and forms by subject and code number. The numbering system enables agency employees and contract personnel to identify the subject of a directive, file, or form. The subject classification codes are to be used to set up, organize, store, and track records in digital and physical form. The codes will be used to identify records on the Office File Plan (OFP) and identify record material that should be protected. The order should be used in conjunction with the FAA Order 1350.14 Records Management series.

The classification system ensures consistency in recordkeeping throughout the agency, assists in facility evaluation, and negates the requirement to retrain personnel who move from one FAA location to another. The use of this system aids in categorizing, filing, and locating information.

This order provides information about coding and classifying subject categories for information management activities, but additional guidance may be required.

## Chapter 1. General Information

- 1. Purpose.** This order prescribes the FAA Standard Subject Classification System for classifying by subject and code number the FAA correspondence, directives, files, and forms.
- 2. Audience.** This Order applies to all FAA Lines of Business (LOBs), Staff Offices (SOs), officials, employees, contractors, interns, and interagency agreement assignees.

- 4. Cancellation** This revision cancels Order 0000.IG, FAA Standard Subject Classification System, dated March 14, 2001.
- 5. Explanation of Policy Changes.**
  - a. Updates classification codes and guidance.
  - b. Updates Appendix 1, consolidated list of all Classification Codes, associated key words, and terminology.

## Chapter 2. Description

### 1. Description of FAA Standard Classification System.

- a. The System provides a standard subject classification numbering system to identify agency documents.
- b. Primary Classification Codes (First 2 numbers/Bold in Appendix A) contain a numerical classification of major series.
- c. Individual Classification Codes (Last 2 numbers) divide the major series into specific topics or activities. The appendix provides associated keywords, terminology, titles, and topics to assist users in locating codes.

### 2. Assignment and Revision of Subject Classification Codes.

- a. The subject classification codes will be assigned based on overall agency needs. Deletions will be made to subject classification codes when the program area has been abolished. The system is based on the subject matter alone. Blocks of code numbers are not assigned to individual organizations for exclusive use.
- b. The subject classification codes refer only to the subject of a document or document group and not the records retention schedule. A records retention should not be “inferred” from the subject classification. A record’s retention can be found on the corresponding National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) approved Records Retention Schedule, on either a General Records Schedule (GRS) or an FAA Records Control Schedule.
- c. Continue to use the existing classification codes on previously issued materials unless revising or reissuing. When a document is revised or reissued, contact your LOB/SO Record Liaison Officer for assistance in identifying the correct subject classification code.
- d. Review and compare the record content to the GRS/FAA schedules located at: [FAA Schedule Management](#) or contact your LOB/SO Record Liaison Officer for assistance.
- e. Submit requests for new or revised classification codes to the Strategy and Performance Services, Records Management Branch (ASP-130), at [9-faa-records-management-program@faa.gov](mailto:9-faa-records-management-program@faa.gov) or through a [Records Management \(RM\) Inquiry Form](#).

### 3. Using this System.

- a. To choose the most appropriate subject classification code or to locate a specific subject, look at Appendix A, List of Classification Codes, which includes a column containing “Associated Keywords and Terminology.” If the exact subject is not listed, look for a closely related subject or contact your Records Liaison Officer (RLO) for assistance.
- b. There may be several factors to consider when assigning a record a classification code. For example:

(1) Correspondence, directive, file, or form, which concerns more than one specific subject within a general subject area, should be assigned the Primary Subject Classification Code for the general subject area. For example, a directive that covers both Air Carrier Airmen Certification (8410) and General Aviation Airmen Certification (8610 and 8710) would be given the broader subject number 8000, General.

(2) The functions and audience may affect the classification code(s) assigned when setting up correspondence files. For example, a Flight Standards District Office might have relatively voluminous correspondence files under the number 8410, Air Carrier Airmen Certification, and might subdivide 8410 in accordance with standard filing procedures. Another organization, however, might require only one code to cover all correspondence from 8000 to 8999, and

(3) The function and audience may affect the classification code assigned. For example, instructions on the use of rental automobiles could be under 2700, Accounting (guidance for accounting organizations), or 4670, Motor Vehicle Management Files (guidance for the management, operation, and maintenance of motor vehicles).

**4. Conversion.** It is not necessary to revise directives, documents, files, or forms merely to use the new classification codes. When an issuance is revised or reissued for other reasons, the new code must be used.
