| Subject:     | Cancellation of FAA Order 1380.51: Program Tracking and Reporting<br>Subsystem, Dated 11/08/1989 and FAA Order 1380.54: Vital Information<br>Subsystem, Dated 07/01/1998 |

Flight Standards Service is requesting the cancellation of FAA Order 1380.51: Program Tracking and Reporting Subsystem, dated 11/08/1989, and FAA Order 1380.54: Vital Information Subsystem, dated 07/01/1998. Regulatory Support Division, AFS-600, in cooperation with Safety Analysis and Promotion Division, AFS-900, conducted an ad-hoc review to establish a gap analysis of the policy guidance contained within these orders and the existing policy and guidance currently in FAA Order 8900.1, Volume 10.

This review determined that FAA Order 1380.51, Program Tracking and Reporting Subsystem is now obsolete and/or no longer needed.

This review determined that FAA Order 1380.54, Vital Information Subsystem is in need of several updates and has obsolete nomenclature references. AFS-900 is currently developing draft guidance to include in an upcoming release of FAA Order 8900.1, Volume 10.
