SUBJ: COORDINATION PROCEDURES FOR NOTICES TO AIRMEN ISSUED TO ESTABLISH 14 CFR PART 91.141 TEMPORARY FLIGHT RESTRICTIONS ASSOCIATED WITH PRESIDENTIAL MOVEMENT

1. **PURPOSE.** This Order establishes policy and assigns responsibilities for dissemination of information regarding Flight Data Center (FDC) Notices to Airmen (NOTAMs) that establish Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFRs) pertaining to 14 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 91.141, Temporary Flight Restrictions in the Proximity of the Presidential and Other Parties. This Order precludes the need for individual Letters of Agreement between Southern Region Automated Flight Service Stations (AFSSs) and other Air Traffic Control (ATC) facilities regarding this subject.
2. **DISTRIBUTION.** This Order is distributed to Branch Level in the Air Traffic Division, all Southern Region air traffic field facilities, and one copy to ACE-530, AEA-530, AGL-530, and ASW-530.
3. **SCOPE.** The responsibilities outlined below are to be used by Southern Region air traffic field facilities upon notification of the issuance of an FDC NOTAM establishing a temporary flight restriction for a presidential movement, hereafter referred to as an FDC Presidential TFR NOTAM. The procedures outlined below provide a process to ensure receipt and dissemination of this critical information and are supplemental to the current issue of FAA Orders 7210.3 and 7930.2.
4. **RESPONSIBILITIES.**
 - a. **Automated Flight Service Stations (AFSS)**


(1) In order to facilitate the coordination of FDC Presidential TFR NOTAM information and to satisfy notification requirements, each AFSS must be aware of the geographical boundaries of all ATC facilities within its flight plan area. Therefore, each AFSS shall coordinate with all en route and terminal ATC facilities having airspace jurisdiction within the AFSS flight plan area to ensure adequate information is available to make such a determination. It is suggested that, as a minimum, charts be developed or obtained which graphically depict the ATC airspace boundaries, including latitude/longitude coordinates. For part-time facilities, the hours of operation should be noted and the facility that assumes control of the airspace during other times should be identified. AFSS's may elect the option of notifying all VFR Airport Traffic Control Towers (ATCTs) that are located within 10 miles of a Presidential TFR boundary rather than coordinating individual airport surface area dimensions in advance.

(2) Review and update internal procedures to comply with the provisions of this Order regarding FDC Presidential TFR NOTAMs.

(3) Maintain information of all facility geographical boundaries that lie in your flight plan area.

(4) Upon receipt of an FDC Presidential TFR NOTAM, determine which facility will be affected. Utilize any locally developed information, as well as any available aeronautical charts and publications to assist in making this determination.

b. All air traffic facilities shall inform the associated AFSS when any changes are made to airspace geographical boundaries or hours of operation.



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
