

SUBJ: Regional Procedures for Coordinating 14 CFR 91.141 Flight Data Center (FDC) Notices to Airmen (NOTAMS)

1. **PURPOSE.** This Order supplements the requirements of the current version of FAA Order 7930.2, (NOTAMS) paragraph 3-1-4. It describes procedures for disseminating information concerning Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFR) implemented pursuant to 14 CFR Part 91.141 within the Western-Pacific (WP) Region.
 2. **DISTRIBUTION.** This Order is being distributed to the branch level and above in the Western-Pacific Region, Air Traffic Division and to all WP Air Traffic Control Facilities at the standard level.
 3. **BACKGROUND.** As a result of several incidents of intrusion into Temporary Flight Restrictions, issued pursuant to 14 CFR Part 91.141, the procedure for the dissemination of these NOTAMS has been changed. All references to TFR in this Order, refer only to TFRs issued pursuant to 14 CFR 91.141. The procedures for handling all other types of TFRs and FDC NOTAMS remain unchanged.
 4. **PROCEDURES.** When notified by Terminal Operations/Procedures, ATP-120, that a TFR has been requested for an area in the Western-Pacific Region, Air Traffic will do the following:
 - a. Operations Branch, AWP-530 will do the following:
 - (1) Determine, in advance of the NOTAM issuance, which Air Traffic Control (ATC) facilities will be affected by each specific TFR.
 - (2) Disseminate this information to affected Automated Flight Service Station (AFSS) operations and affected ATC facilities.
 - b. All AWP AFSS's will do the following:
 - (1) When the FDC NOTAM is issued, coordinate with ATC facilities identified by AWP-530 to ensure receipt of the FDC NOTAM information.
 - (2) If necessary, fax the information to the ATC facility.
- NOTE: The AFSS may determine the method to be used to ensure receipt of the information by the affected facility.
- (3) Make an entry in the Daily Record of Facility Operations when all affected facilities have been notified.

(4) In the event advance notification by AWP-530, including identification of affected facilities, is not received, affected facilities will be determined and notified as deemed appropriate by the AFSS OS/CIC (Operation's Supervisor/Controller-in-Charge).

c. Affected ATC facilities will make an entry in the Daily Record of Facility/Operations when notification has been received from the AFSS.
